## Driveways

After your driveway is installed, avoid heavy vehicles or sharp objects for the first 72 hours to allow the surface to cure fully.



Keep the driveway free of standing water, especially in winter, to prevent frost damage and staining.

Clean regularly with a hose or soft broom to remove dirt, leaves, and grime—avoid abrasive tools or harsh chemicals.

For concrete or asphalt, apply a protective sealant within 3–6 months of installation, and reseal every 3–5 years depending on wear.

Avoid using salt or de-icing products in winter—opt for eco-friendly alternatives to prevent surface damage.

To prevent oil stains, cover car exhausts and promptly clean up any spills. If you notice cracks or uneven areas, call us for a professional assessment—early repair prevents larger issues.

With simple, consistent care, your driveway will maintain its strength, appearance, and value for many years.
